Food Warriors Youth Development Program Assistant to Site Coordinator

This is a 12-month contractual position. The rate of pay is \$15.00 per hour for a maximum of 10 hours per week.

Requirements

Applicants must submit to a State of Michigan and Federal criminal background check. Must have experience working with children. Must be able to relate well to youth, teachers, administrators, and parents. Must have some knowledge of the food system, and urban agriculture. Must have basic knowledge and understanding of African and African American history and culture. Must have excellent organizational and communication skills. Must be reliable, accountable and a team player. Must have access to reliable transportation.

Duties

- Assist DBCFSN's Food Warriors site coordinators in facilitating weekly Food Warriors after school and Saturday program sessions.
- There are currently three Food Warriors Program sites:
 - Barack Obama Leadership Academy (formerly Timbuktu Academy of Science and Technology)—Tuesdays & Thursdays 4:00pm-5:30pm
 - McDowell Preparatory Academy Mondays 4:00-5:30 & Wednesdays 1:30-3:00pm
 - Saturday Community Program at the Shrine of the Black Madonna—Saturdays
 11:00am-1:00pm (Shrine program currently meets virtually due to pandemic)
- Assist with the 16-week Saturday Food N'Flava Youth Entrepreneurial Program. Food N'Flava meets for four hours on Saturdays from June-September.
- Assist site coordinator with lessons and activities.
- Assist with garden maintenance.
- Keep accurate inventory of tools and equipment at each site.
- Assist with the building and repair of raised beds at each site.
- Some moderately heavy lifting may be involved.
- Other duties as assigned.
- Reports to DBCFSN assigned Food Warriors site coordinator.
